#### Overview

Habitat for Humanity of Clallam County is seeking a dependable Truck Driver and Customer Service Representative, who will be responsible for picking up donations of furniture, appliances, and other items in Port Angeles and Sequim, along with a variety of duties, including point of sale, in the store.

# **Key Responsibilities Include:**

Truck Driver

- Lifting and moving heavy objects/furniture—minimum of 75 lbs. or more with assistance
- Scheduling/confirming pickups
- Understanding and use of ThriftCart Pick-up software
- Back-up driving when needed and loading the truck for pickups
- Making go/no-go decisions on acceptability of donations at point of pickup/receipt
- Asking for monetary donations
- Provide receipts for all donated goods
- Unloading truck following pickups
- Weekly inspection and maintenance check on truck and truck equipment
- Clean interior and exterior of truck as needed
- Adherence to all safety regulations at the store
- Minor repairs (within capability) e.g., replenishing fluids, replacing lights, securing interior "tiedowns", etc
- Adherence to all driving/traffic rules and regulations
- Assist in keeping the warehouse clean and organized
- Assist in cleaning, testing, and processing donations

## Customer Service Representative

- Develop sufficient knowledge of merchandise and store procedures to serve as Representative On Duty (primary "go to" person for volunteers and customers)
- Resolve customer or service problems
- Assist with overall safety, organization, and cleanliness of warehouse, store, and truck.
- Assist with product testing, repair, and cleaning.



- Assist with marketing, sales, and social media promotions.
- Clean, process, and price inventory.
- Participation in various community fundraising events.
- Keep an eye out for potential safety hazards and eliminate them or bring them to the attention of someone who can.

# Requirements:

- Must be "team-oriented, committed to customer service, and have strong people skills. Should have the ability to be "customer friendly", yet firm.
- Good communication skills (written and verbal), phone presence, and positive professional demeanor required.
- Needs to be organized and able to work with others to effectively position ever-changing inventory in the existing space.
- Must be able to lift and move heavy objects/furniture—minimum of 75 lbs. or more with assistance.
- Familiarity with e-mail, Microsoft Excel, and Word are desirable.
- Must be able to clearly and passionately articulate the mission of Habitat for Humanity and the Store.

## **Compensation & Benefits**

- Salary: Wage Range \$18.00-\$22.00, DOE
- 75% of Health Care Premiums, after 60 days. (Employee pays 25% via payroll deduction).
- 100% of Dental and Vision Premiums, after 60 days
- Paid time off and 14 paid holidays. PTO (sick and vacation) accrued monthly and available after 90 days as per Employee Handbook (issued January 2023)
- Vacation and sick-time will be accrued at a full-time rate.
